

Kenneth Hall is a small terminus station. It was built at the end of a branch line to serve the farms of the Hall. This was so the farms of the estate could get their produce to town. There is a small engine shed for a station pilot engine so that when the train for the town can be assembled for when the daily freight arrives for drop off and pick up. There are also watering and coaling facilities for the engines.

The boards for the layout are constructed out of 4 x 2 timber with a 4mm plywood top. The track used is Peco Code 100 and laid on cork.

This layout has been designed and built so the team can learn how to construct and wire a layout. It has a basic layout plan with the complication of a double slip. The layout is wired for DC controlling.
